Fenwood Creek Watershed Cost-shareable Practices



Fenwood Watershed Large Scale Targeted Runoff Management (TRM) Grant

The Targeted Runoff Management (TRM) Grant Program is a cost-share reimbursement grant program. The maximum cost-share rate is up to 70% of eligible expenses (up to 90% for economic hardship), up to a maximum award of \$600,000.

Some of the common practices that can be cost-shared are listed in the table to the right.

Contour farming	\$9.00 per acre
Strip Cropping	\$13.00 per acre

Cropland protection (cover crop)	\$25.00 per acre per year
Nutrient management	\$40.00 per acre (one-time payment)
